
The Light Bulb program (TLB):




Update on SEEED-IGI Book project:

Evaluation of Economic Progression Across Middle-income Americans: Narratives and Research Perspectives (EEPAMANRP).



The send-out of questionnaires (Q1-6: consent, demographics, income, education, socio-religious, dynamic politics) is on-going. The collation of candidate responses, analysis of meta-data, and the development and writing of subject narratives have been initiated and are on-going (Figure 1: schematic diagram of methodology for EEPAMANRP book project).


Points to ponder.....



- The authors affirm that every participant had an excellent understanding of the premise of the study.
- Each candidate respondent voluntarily consented to be a part of project EEPAMANRP..


Close to one hundred invitations have been sent out to candidates who meet the strict eligibility criteria of this study. Candidates must be American citizens and must earn an annual income of \geq \$20,000 USD and above. Although responses have been consistent, we are yet to meet the target numbers required to initiate all segments of project EEPAMANRP. The authors humbly request that respondents complete and submit questionnaires (Q1-6) received fastidiously and expeditiously.

- 93.5% of respondents were determined to be in the American workforce.
- While 6.5% of respondents may have been in the workforce at some point, they were not a part of the workforce at the time they completed the survey.

- A plurality of respondents are traditional Christian conservatives.
- Progressives and liberals constitute a significant portion of the surveyed population.

Q5.2. To your mind, what is the world's (people of the world) leading contemporary hot button issue today?


